- Please indicate the extent of your contact with the applicant and include any information
 that might assist us in evaluating the applicant's ability to adjust and adapt to a foreign
 culture. Also, please comment specifically on the applicant's ability to work with people,
 quality of work, and career aspirations that may motivate the applicant to participate in the
 JET Programme.
- References must be original copies and must include a hand-signed signature, verified digital signatures can also be accepted. References written as the body of an email will not be accepted.
- References must be on headed paper. If headed paper is not available, we request that you
 inform us at the time of submission.
- References must be dated.
- Please include full contact details as we may contact you to clarify some contents of the reference letter.
